Minutes

3:01 - Jerry Oldroyd shares KSL article about trustlands money.

3:03 - Youtube video about trustlands. Liz Mumford video about community council rules and regulations

3:10 - Jerry points out a 12 percent increase of trustlands funds from the previous year.

3:11 - Mike Ulrich will be the Chair of the Board and Shalon will be Vice Chair.

3:13 - Copies of the Dibels results graph of district elementary schools are passed out while Jerry explains the results.

3:14 - Jerry shares 2016-17 SAGE results for South elementary, 3rd and 4th grades combined.

Trustlands money from last year is being used for math aides this year for struggling students.

Those positions are hired to help the mathematics scores for this year. Trustlands money has normally been used to support students in language arts. Linda is bringing students from SUU to help our students. Scores are close to statewide scores.

3:18 - School Improvement Plan. Review of last years goals. There will be changes for this year.

One of our goals is to reduce bullying. PBIS reinforce positive behavior. Teachers hand out blue slips when they see a student do something good, which goes towards rewards, such as drawings

in assemblies. Student spotlight in school assemblies. Adding these things to school improvement plan for the board to look over.

3:21 - Digital Citizenship. How are we using computers in school. District filters and their safety. AUP is for students' parents must sign. If not signed by the district-established deadline, students are not allowed to use school devices and computers.

3:23 - Adding a few new board members next year, hopefully.

3:25 - Jerry moves to appoint Mike to Chair of the Board. Shalon and Keith second that motion. Dates for next meeting? Possibly each quarter and in the spring during the next SEP week? Jerry tells the board where the money is going toward, including a library aide, math aides, and language arts aides. Some money is used for materials. Secondary schools use their money for professional development. A few years back, some money was used for chromebooks.

Chromebooks are in all 3rd-5th grade classrooms. We may need to get 5 more for the library. It's difficult to replace old chromebooks due to the districts 5 year limitation rule.

3:29 - Jerry brings up the \$92 million bond coming up in the November election. Money will go toward entrances, middle school classrooms, and new schools. Shalon asked about the entry ways. Jerry explains the security concerns surrounding unlocked and open entrances, particularly after school shootings. Trying to put in cameras in all schools. The school board can decide to increase taxes, but it would get very little in comparison to the bond. Shalon asked about the district spreading the information. Jerry explains that the district is mailing out information.
