January 24th -- April 24th, 2021

Preschool/Head Start: 60 Minutes/ Week
(Parents reading to children for 720 Minutes)

K-1st: 70 Minutes/ Week (Total 840 Minutes)

2nd - 3rd: 85 Minutes/ Week (Total 1020 Minutes)

4th - 6th: 125 Minutes/ Week (Total 1500 Minutes)

Reading can be done any day during the week as long as the per week reading minimum is achieved.

Our goal is for each child to read DAILY.

(One extra week is included for vacation or sick days, only 12 weeks must be completed.)

How to Receive Your Prize
