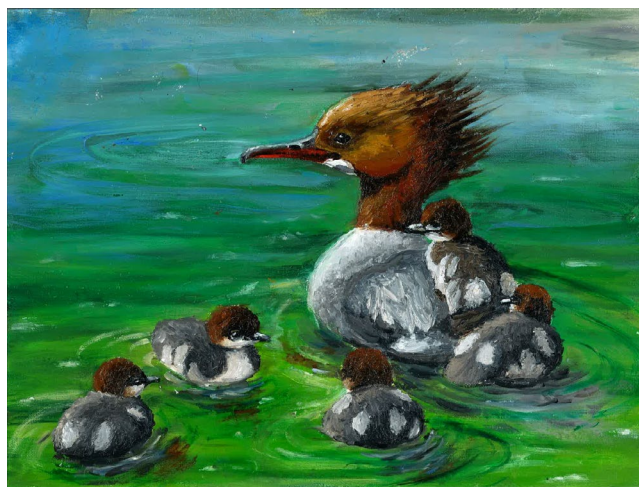


Junior Duck Stamp Art Contest

Students in kindergarten through high school attending public, private or home schools in the United States and the U.S. Territories are eligible to participate.
